Unbeknownst to Analiese, she and the others on the list are descendants of the Gods of Death. They have the power to raise the dead and control them, but those raised become strong and evil, with a tendency of decaying and losing limbs

During their search, they discover Micah's grandfather belonged to a group, pledged to save and protect the Death Risers from two groups of gods and their descendants. One wants to control them and use the Raised for an army, and the other wants to destroy them.

If Analiese and Micah don't decipher the clues to finding out the truth about her and whom she should trust, Analiese could end up being a puppet to the wrong set of gods and become the destroyer of humankind as we know it.

Brenda Drake grew up the youngest of three children, an Air Force brat, and the continual new kid at school. Her fondest memories growing up are of her eccentric, Irish grandmother's animated tales, which gave her a strong love for storytelling. Lindsey Frydman


A contemporary love story with a small paranormal twist: what happens when you've found the one, only for the future to show he dies in your arms?


Could you kill an innocent life today to save millions in the future?

Ella isn't anyone's pet anymore, but she's certainly not free.

After exposing the dark secrets about NuPet's breeding program, forcing them to repeal the law that allowed genetically modified girls to be kept as pets, she thought girls like her would finally be free. But she never dreamed that it would backfire. NuPet may have convinced the public of their intentions to assimilate pets back into society, but Ella knows it's a lie.

They aren't planning mass rehabilitation... they're planning a mass *extermination*.

Now, with the help of a small group of rebels, she's set on finding a way to bring down NuPet for good. But when her group gets implicated in a string of bombings, it becomes clear that none of them are safe—not her, not Penn, not even his family. Remember how many lies we told, Molly? It's enough to make my head spin. You were wild when I met you, and I was mad for you. But then something happened. And now you're gone.


But don't worry. I'll find you. I just need to sift through the story of us to get to where you might be. I've got places to look, and a list of names.



Cole Gibsen


Full of mystery and romance, the second book in the Blood Eternal series is a fast-paced, literary thriller.

Then the murders start, bodies that are burned to a crisp. After being burned, the dead stay dead. Key is running out of time to discover who she was—and what secret someone is willing to kill to keep hidden—before she becomes the next victim.
