
Dr. Yvonne Kason's life was touched by five near-death experiences (NDEs), the most recent in 2003. Her dramatic near-death experience in a 1979 plane crash propelled her as a young medical doctor to research and counsel people with diverse types of peak spiritual experiences. In 1994, she coined the phrase "spiritually transformative experiences" (STEs), a term widely used today. These include near-death experiences, mystical experiences, spiritual energy or kundalini awakenings, diverse psychic experiences, and inspired creativity.

Touched by the Light is an inspiring and informative synthesis of forty years of STE research, filled with fascinating case studies. Dr. Kason shares her pioneering framework for STEs and describes their often profound after-effects on body, mind, and spirit. She offers a much needed bridge between Western medical understanding and spiritual states of consciousness.





Uncertain of their son's fate, his family leaped into action.

The sinking of the passenger liner *Lusitania* was a maritime disaster that may have changed the course of history by making American involvement in the First World War almost inevitable. This part of the story has been told before but *The Lusitania Sinking* has a far more personal tale to tell, of a family looking for information about their son's death.


On May 1, 1915, Preston Prichard, a twenty-nine-year-old student, embarked as a second-class passenger on the *Lusitania*, bound from New York for Liverpool. Just after 2:00 p.m. on May 7, a single torpedo, fired by the German submarine *U-20*, caused a massive explosion in the *Lusitania*'s hold, and the ship began to sink rapidly. Within twenty minutes she disappeared and 1,198 men, women, and children, including Preston, died.

Preston's mother wrote hundreds of letters to survivors to find out more about what might have happened in his last moments. The replies she received included many moving and evocative survivors' accounts. Though not her intention, Mrs. Pritchard assembled an outstanding collection of vivid first-hand recollections. *The Lusitania Sinking* tells the tragic story, using this previously unseen historical treasure trove.





Debi's husband, Peter, was diagnosed with cancer in November 2015, too late in the season to seek solace in gardening. Ever since her childhood on a Niagara farm, Debi has dug in the dirt to find resilience. With idle hands and a mind filled with fear, she now sought something to sustain her through the months ahead. The cost is enormous: excess nutrients are contaminating air and water; soil is being depleted; species loss is plunging us to the sixth extinction; and farmers are racking up debt, increasingly vulnerable to economic and climatic shifts.


Plus, too much food is being consumed. Two-thirds of health-care costs in Canada can now be attributed to chronic diseases associated with unhealthy eating. And then there is the waste! Householders, along with food processors, distributors, wholesalers, and retailers, are wasting 40 percent of the food produced.

A radical rethink is required. We need to move from excess to enough.






A visual tour-de-force showcasing Toronto's vast concert history.

Drawing from The Flyer Vault, a vast collection of flyers and concert advertisements, Daniel Tate and Rob Bowman have assembled a beautifully illustrated showcase of Toronto concert and club life, covering the gamut of genres — from vaudeville to rock, jazz to hip-hop, blues to electronica, and punk to country.

The Flyer Vault: 150 Years of Toronto Concert History traces seminal events in Toronto's concert history, such as Frank Sinatra's debut at a long-lost hockey arena, James Brown's first show at an Etobicoke roller-rink, Led Zeppelin selling out the Rockpile, and the Notorious B.I.G.'s only Toronto show in a basement cafeteria.

Complementing the book's stunning visuals are a series of essays that tell the story of legendary venues such as Massey Hall, the Horseshoe Tavern, and the El Mocambo, alongside lesser known but equally important theatres such as Shea's and the Casino Club.

Daniel Tate started The Flyer Vault on Instagram in 2015 after rediscovering thousands of flyers he had collected over the years. He lives in Toronto. **Rob Bowman** is a professor of music at York University who has been writing about music for over forty years. His book Soulsville U.S.A.: The Story of Stax Records was inducted into the Blues Hall of Fame in 2013. He lives in Toronto.




The town of Ford is quickly becoming a hotspot for the smuggling of illegal liquor.




Ex-con Jack Palace returns in a world of violence, heartbreak, and revenge.





Although decidedly different from each other — in personality, in the planes they flew, and in their contribution to the war effort — they all shared a passion for flying and a strong sense of duty. One hundred years after they flew and fought for king and country, *Masters of the Air* brings these three men to life, detailing their development as pilots, their battles in the air, and their near-death experiences.
