Avoiding ecological bankruptcy requires rigorous resource accounting — challenging, but doable with the right tools.

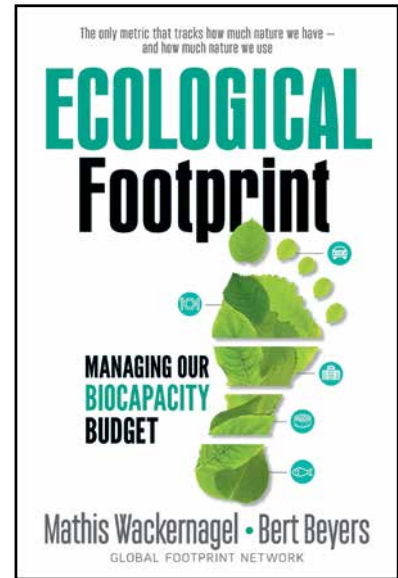

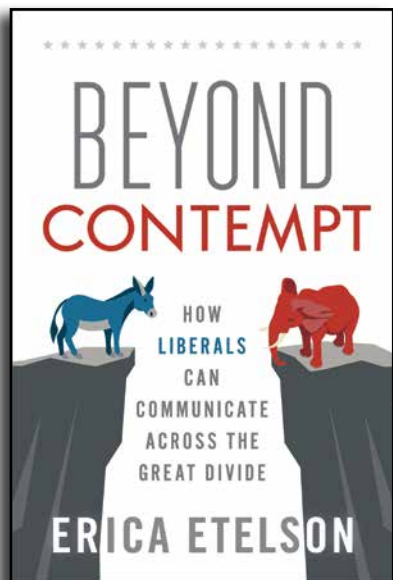

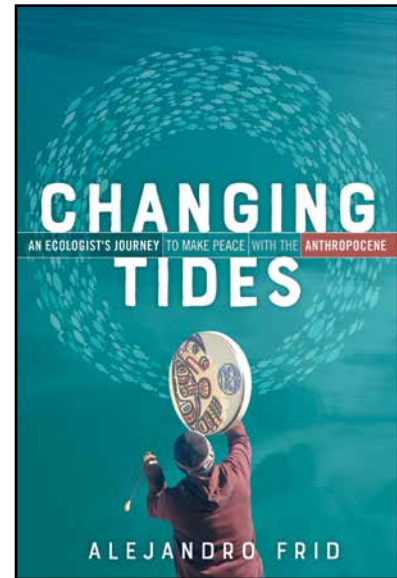
AS HUMANITY MARCHES ON, causing mass extinctions and destabilizing the climate, the future of Earth will reflect the stories that Homo sapiens decides to jettison or accept into our collective identity. At this pivotal moment in history, the most important story we can tell ourselves is that humans are not inherently destructive.

Alejandro Frid tackles the big questions: who, or what, represents our essential selves, and what stories might allow us to shift the collective psyche of industrial civilization in time to avert the worst of the climate and biodiversity crises?

In seeking the answers, Frid draws from personal experience and that of Indigenous colleagues, finding a glimmer of hope in Indigenous cultures that, despite the ravages of colonialism, have for thousands of years developed intentional and socially complex practices for resource management that epitomize sustainability. Ultimately, Frid argues, merging scientific perspectives with Indigenous knowledge might just help us change the stories about who we are and where we could go.

Changing Tides is for everyone concerned with the crises we have unleashed upon our planet, and how we might steer towards a more benign Anthropocene.

ALEJANDRO FRID, PH.D., an ecologist for First Nations of British Columbia's Central Coast, and Adjunct Assistant Professor at the University of Victoria, has for over two decades inhabited the worlds of science, modern Indigenous cultures, and climate activism.
