Coleman's informed text describes the field in which founder Jean Zuber was an expert, illustrating that Zuber's wallpapers are as magical today as when they were first created.

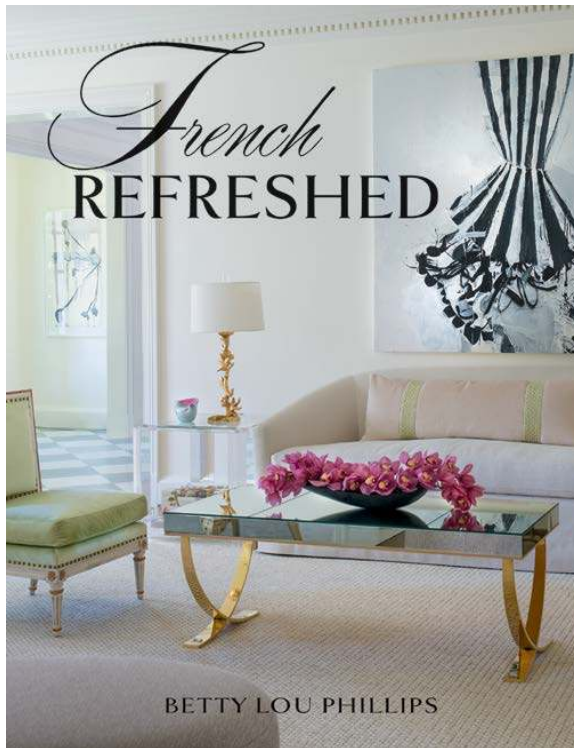

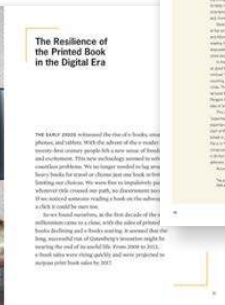
DESIGNING AND CURATING A HOME LIBRARY
